

## Neilston Windfarm Legacy (NWL) - Grant Conditions 2026

### READ THESE GRANT CONDITIONS ALONG WITH THE GUIDANCE NOTES

1. Grants will be awarded to properly **constituted** community groups, associations and organisations, charities, social enterprises and similar other non-government organisations. An unconstituted group will only occasionally be considered for grant funding, at the discretion of the Board of Trustees.
2. The project must demonstrate direct benefit to the 'community of Neilston', which is defined in NWL's constitution as the **G78 3\*\* postcode** area.
3. The aims of the project must be consistent with NWL's own charitable objectives.
4. The group or organisation must have an equal opportunities policy and, if they are dealing with children under 18 years old or vulnerable adults, have put in place policies appropriate to these groups.
5. Before an approved grant is paid the group or organisation must provide NWL with details of their official bank account and copies of their three most recent bank statements.
6. The group or organisation in receipt of the grant must acknowledge the support of both NWL and NWL's founder NDT (Neilston Development Trust) in all types of publicity and in the organisation's annual report.
7. Grants must only be used for the purpose approved by NWL; in the event of an underspend permission must be sought from NWL for any other potential use.
8. Grants may not be used to pay a wage to anyone on the management committee or board of the group or the organisation in receipt of the grant.
9. The group or organisation must provide one or more written progress reports to NWL during the lifetime of the project and if requested financial information such as budget records, invoices or receipts, or other proof of project delivery.
10. Additional conditions may be set by the NWL Trustees at their discretion.
